This local law opts out of allowing retail cannabis dispensaries and on-site consumption establishments from locating and operating within the boundaries of the Town of Lenox.

SAID LOCAL LAW IS SUBJECT TO A PERMISSIVE REFERENDUM. Petitions for a referendum may be obtained from the Town Clerk and must be filed within forty-five (45) days of the Notice of this Adoption.
